

Victoria's education and training regulator – Supporting international students in Victoria

Checklist for students and their parents on choosing education and training in Victoria.

- Is the training college registered by the Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority? – check the college details on the State Register at: www.vrqa.vic.gov.au
- Is the course you want provided by the college and is it approved for delivery to international students – check the college's approved courses on the State Register?
- Will this course help you achieve your career goals?
- Have you (or someone you know and trust) visited the college in Victoria to meet the staff, see the facilities and understand where it is located?
- Do you know the total costs of enrolling in the course including – application fees, tuition fees, books and equipment, assessment and reassessment fees?
- Do you know what the real costs of living in Victoria will be – accommodation, transport, food, entertainment?
- Have you compared the cost and duration of the course with others offered by colleges in Victoria?
- Do you meet the admission requirements for the course, including English Language proficiency?
- Have you read the college prospectus, student handbook and course requirements?
- Have you requested a copy of the college enrolment agreement/contract?
- Do you understand your rights and obligations as an international student in Australia?
